Applications are invited from citizens of Kazakhstan for scholarships awarded under Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR)'s General Scholarship Scheme for the academic year 2020-21 for studying Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral Research programmes in Universities/Educational Institutions in India. The scholarships are granted for pursuing studies in various subjects such as Arts, Science, Engineering, Business Administration, Accounts, Commerce, Performing Arts and Humanities.

For B.Sc., B.E / B.Tech courses, candidates should have taken Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM) in their school leaving examinations, as this is mandatory criteria for these courses. Applicants are necessarily of 18 years age at the time of admission in Indian Universities/ Institutes and not more than 30 years of age. The applicants should have good knowledge of English language to enable them to pursue higher education in India.

The interested candidates should submit applications **by 20 February 2020 only through the online application mechanism at ICCR Scholarship Application Portal <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/>**. Last date to apply on PhD courses is **20 August 2020**.
